

2023 Scholarship Application Form



Plymouth Area Community Television (PACTV) is a nonprofit membership-based organization that serves the towns of Duxbury, Kingston, Pembroke and Plymouth. PACTV provides video production training to people interested in creating their own television shows, coverage of government meetings, educational access at Pembroke High School, Silver Lake Regional Middle School and Silver Lake Regional High School, assistance to area nonprofit organizations and other community-service based projects. Since PACTV provides Educational access in the town of Pembroke, we are proud to award this scholarship to a Pembroke Resident who is receiving their high school diploma or equivalent from an accredited and licensed school or program. The PACTV Scholarship committee will review all applications and will be comprised of PACTV staff and Board of Directors.

The Scholarship Committee will award a total of \$1,000 in scholarships (the Committee has the right to choose to give scholarships in the amounts of \$250 up to \$1,000). *This is a one-time award and will not recur in subsequent years to recipients.*

In order to be considered for this scholarship, this form must be completed, include all mandatory information and mailed or brought to the PACTV Educational Access Department by April 7, 2023.

Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Pembroke
- Must be graduating from high school or receiving a completion of studies from an equivalent type of educational program which is accredited and licensed to provide educational programming within the state of Massachusetts.
- Must be pursuing a communications-related field (i.e., film, video production, broadcast journalism, graphics arts, multi-media studies, digital media, visual arts, etc.) at an accredited 2 or 4 year college or a post high school technical school during the coming academic year.

** Beginning in the 2022/23 school year, participation in Titan TV program will be required to be considered for this scholarship. **

Scholarship(s) will be awarded at Senior Awards Night at Pembroke High School for students enrolled at PHS. Recipient(s), after successful completion of their first semester (with a C average or better) will mail a copy of their transcripts to Erika Christensen c/o PACTV, 4 Collins Ave., Plymouth, MA 02360. Once the transcript is received, a check will be mailed directly to the scholarship recipient(s).
